

Notice of Master Plan

The Municipality of Mississippi Mills How We Flow: Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Master Plan

The Municipality of Mississippi Mills has completed a Master Planning process, in accordance with Approach 1 of the Municipal Engineers Association (MEA) Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) process, to develop Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Master Plan. This Master Plan developed water and wastewater servicing strategies to align with updated population projections to meet demand from existing and future service areas in Almonte for the next 25 years

Based on the study findings, input from technical agencies and the public, the Master Plan is now completed. The preferred alternatives include sanitary sewer and watermain upgrades; as well as additional studies required for expansions to potable water treatment, potable water storage, wastewater pumping, and wastewater treatment.

The recommended projects are presented in the Master Plan report, which is currently available for review at the Municipality's website:

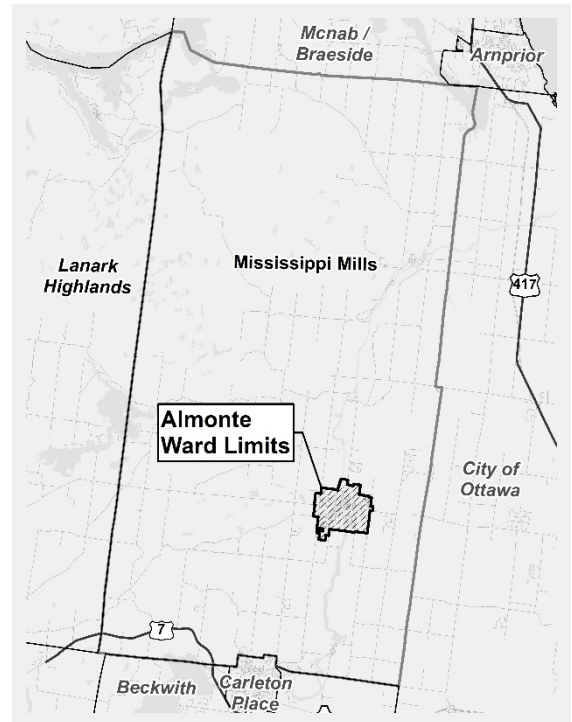
