We are currently seeking an Engineering Technician to join our team. Reporting directly to the Director of Development Services and Engineering, the Engineering Technologist is responsible for reviewing development applications and providing input as part of the pre-consultation process for proposed development and assisting in the development of policies and procedures as it relates to the development review process. The position assists with the management of capital projects including the preparation of detailed designs, tenders, contracts and agreements and ensures coordination between development applications and capital projects. The position also provides input and assists with the management of long-range master plans.

- ✓ Surveying and inspection experience along with the ability to review engineering plans and studies.
- ✓ Understanding and knowledge of provincial engineering standards and regulations.
- ✓ Excellent written and oral communication skills.
- ✓ In depth knowledge of regulations, policies, and guidelines related to Municipal operations and infrastructure.
- ✓ Strong interpersonal skills working with members of the public, developers and applicants, external agencies and a variety of internal municipal departments.
- ✓ Experience and knowledge of Microsoft Office suite of programs including Word, Excel and PowerPoint
